If the MOBO of a server fails it can be replaced within a period of 30 -60 minutes, so typically you see that much downtime..if a hard drive fails then it extends into hours unless you are on Raid systems. Hard drives involves moving parts which are prone to wear and tear with the continuous usage...a new and updated hardware means you are going one step further to protect your customers from potential problems an old hardware can bring...though it may cost much, the investment in better hardware & better network always pays well.

AT WIPL we always choose networks which are rock solid, branded hardwares & the best infrastructure to support it..the result is an unmatched uptime and an unshakable performance. I would not hesitate when I say that today we match and beat almost every web hosting company in India in terms of uptime, we are far far ahead of them in terms of our responsiveness and much better in terms of customer support.
